Trauma Informed Care Means We:

1. Realize the widespread impact of trauma and understand paths for recovery
2. Recognize the signs and symptoms of trauma in patients, families, and staff
3. Integrate knowledge about trauma into policies, procedures, and practices
4. Actively avoid re-traumatization

What is Human Trafficking?

1. Exploitation of a person through Force, Fraud, or Coercion

2. Modern day slavery

- SEX TRAFFICKING
Forcing sex work upon a victim
- LABOR TRAFFICKING
Forced labor with little or no pay
- DOMESTIC SERVITUDE
Forced labor within a home with little or no pay
