# Thank you for considering Sanctum House,

Like so many others, I have been touched by trauma. I had watched my oldest son, Jonathan, check in-and-out of short-term recovery programs struggling with addiction. We learned the long and hard way that quality short-term recovery facilities, those meant for the local community, were rarely free and often cost-prohibitive.

I wanted to find a way to help, if not for my son, then for survivors. I heard Edee educate about the extensive healing journey for trafficking survivors. I learned about the need for shelters and services that treat the lasting impacts of trauma.

The residents first learn trust. They learn to trust that they are safe and supported. Most importantly, they rebuild trust in themselves. Annual Giving is our opportunity to build on their trust. I've watched our Residents doing the hard part. By joining us, committing to our mission and program, we can grow our sanctuary of healing and help more survivors in the future.

The services we provide adapt with each new survivor that walks through our doors. We cannot predict the pieces that need to be put back together, but we've built a place where together, we can find them. Today, our two-year program provides mental and physical healthcare, legal aid, job training, educational opportunities, 24/7 on-site staff, mentorship, and more. We've grown quickly, and already helped over 90 women, but the need is far greater.

As our program proves successful with each new graduate, we build our community of partners, donors, and volunteers. The best way to enable the recovery of trafficking survivors is through a commitment to stand by. We promise to be there; they do the hard work.

# Educational or Research Partnership

Sanctum House relies on and collaborates with the academic community too. All angles of trauma and trafficking require a scholarly approach to understanding potential directions forward, and guide our trauma-informed care.

Our partnership began in 2018, when Michigan School of Psychology (MSP) students began providing clinical services to Sanctum House residents, and with Sanctum House facilitating human trafficking educational programming at MSP.

"We're honored to join with Sanctum House in offering a safe environment for residents to address their traumatic experiences," says Dr. Jim Maher, Director of the Michigan School Psychological Clinic, at MSP. "Our students are gaining invaluable experience while working with this tremendously resilient population."

Sanctum House provides a place and time for survivors of Human Trafficking to heal. We offer comprehensive services including: mental and physical healthcare, job training, financial literacy training, addiction counseling, legal aid, community service opportunity, access to spiritual and religious services, and more.

Relocation, unstable housing and substance use are leading vulnerabilities for victims of trafficking in the United States. Many survivors are trafficked at young ages, by friends, family, employers, neighbors, and increasingly online. Trafficking takes many forms, but all survivors need safe housing, an opportunity to address their individual traumas; space to practice independent living. Our 24 month program, enables treatment and therapies to guide survivors through their healing process. Each Resident works to graduate from Bronze, to Silver, then Gold, before being ready to attempt independent living.

With 24/7 on-site care, Sanctum House is the foundation along the journey, ensuring that Resident Survivors have the chance to succeed, the opportunity to practice and learn, and the time to recover their independence. Thank you for considering joining our mission.
